Asian Carp Fishing Tournament Registration & Rules

Rules

- 1) One hand held dip net per participant. Number of participants per boat only limited by legal limits of boat itself.
- 2) Participants will gather near the boat ramp at heat start-times and will begin when the starting gun goes off. Teams then have two hours to catch as many asian carp as possible. At the end of each two hour heat, teams will bring their catch to the boat ramp for the official tally.
- 3) Abide by all Indiana DNR boating guidelines and restrictions (<http://www.boat-ed.com/indiana/handbook/>)

Suggestions

- While not required, participants should consider wearing helmets and life jackets for protection
 - The fish seem to jump most when boats travel in packs, so working with other boats should prove more effective.
 - The fish seem to run in schools around cover, the deep bends in the river and in the small inlets found up and down the river, but you'll catch them anywhere.
 - Having a trash can or other container to haul fish from boat to count is suggested as well.
